- The 2021-2022 FAFSA launched on October 1st. All students are encouraged to submit the FAFSA early in their senior year. Students enrolling at UCF in summer 2021 will need to complete both the 2020-21 and 2021-22 FAFSA. Our priority financial aid deadline is December 1st. Additional information is available on our Office of Student Financial Assistance website.
- The housing application for summer and fall 2021 will be available at the end of October.
 Students can explore floorplans, costs and view our Living Learning Communities on the Housing website.
- We will begin awarding merit scholarships to admitted students for summer and fall 2021 in early November. Consideration for these awards is automatic; no additional application is required for this award type. Merit scholarship recipients are notified of their offer on myUCF and via mail.
