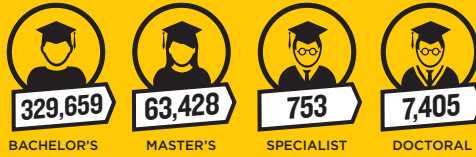

- Career Services helped 44,519 students search and compete for jobs in 2021-22.

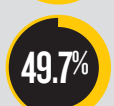
## TOP VALUE EDUCATION

- Kiplinger and *Forbes* rank UCF among the nation's best education values.

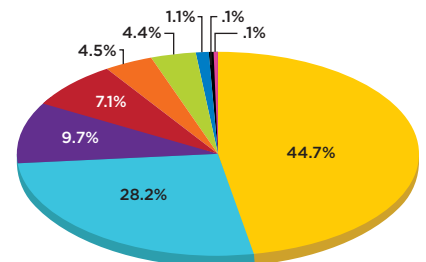


## QUALITY AND DIVERSITY
