INTENT TO RETURN

Federal aid recipients who withdraw from all courses (officially or unofficially) before the 60% point in the semester are subject to a recalculation of awards based on the number of days attended, which results in the students being required to return money back to federal award programs through UCF.

Based on our records, you have been awarded federal aid for summer 2022 and you have withdrawn from all of your courses in the summer A, C, and/or D sessions. If you plan to attend classes in the summer B session, which begins on June 27th, we are required by federal law to collect written confirmation of your intent to return. Please read the following carefully.

- You must submit the completed Summer 2022 Intent to Return form within 5 business days of this communication to avoid a recalculation of your awards if you plan to attend B session. *The form is required even if you are registered for summer B courses.*
- Failure to submit the Summer 2022 Intent to Return form will result in the recalculation of your awards based on the number of days you attended in sessions A, C, and/or D, regardless of any enrollment in session B courses.
- Students who indicate their intent to return for session B and fail to begin attendance in session B courses will be subject to recalculation based on the withdrawal date from summer A, C, and/or D sessions.
- Students who indicate that they do NOT plan to return for session B are fee liable for session B courses for which they registered unless they drop those courses on myUCF before the drop deadline published on the Academic Calendar. Student Financial Assistance does not have the authority to drop classes for students.
