The Estimated Financial Aid Deferment, which appears on the Fee Invoice, is the sum of a student's financial aid awards for the semester.

WHEN DOES FINANCIAL AID DISBURSE?

Financial aid will begin disbursing the week following the end of Drop/Swap and Add for those who have completed all requirements.
