<p><b>COMPLETE YOUR 2016-2017 FAFSA!</b> The UCF priority application date is March 1st each year.</p>
<p><b>WHAT IS AN ESTIMATED FINANCIAL AID DEFERMENT?</b> The Estimated Financial Aid Deferment, which appears on the Fee Invoice, is the sum of a student's financial aid awards for the semester.</p>
<p><b>WHEN DOES FINANCIAL AID DISBURSE?</b> Financial aid will begin disbursing the week following the end of Drop/Swap and Add for those who have completed all requirements.</p>
<p><b>ARE YOU GETTING ALL OF THE NECESSARY INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR FINANCIAL AID?</b> It is extremely important that you activate your Knights Email and check it regularly to avoid missing important and critical information from the Office of Student Financial Assistance and the University.</p>
<p><b>HAVE YOU SATISFIED ALL REQUIREMENTS TO RECEIVE YOUR FINANCIAL AID?</b> Continue to check your "To Do List" on myUCF, Student Center, to ensure that ALL requirements are met.</p>
