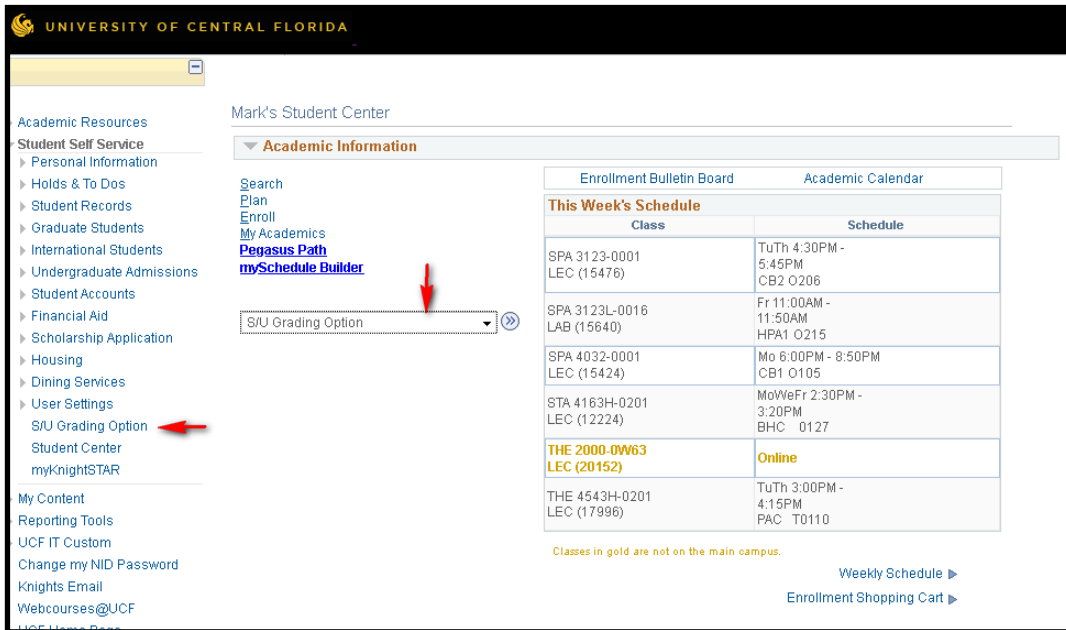




COVID-19 S/U Opt-in Instructions

Between April 10-27, you can submit requests for S/U grading. Go to the myUCF portal and select Student Self Service > Student Center.

You can access the S/U grading opt-in page **two ways**: from a direct link in the portal or from the Other Academics dropdown in the Student Center.



Once on the page, check the box next to the class(es) you want to opt-in for S/U grading.

After clicking the “Save” button, the Grading column (second column) will reflect the new S/U grading choice. Some classes may not be eligible for S/U grading. Consult with your advisor regarding any questions you may have about opting-in for S/U grading.

You can opt-in to S/U grading, or undo a prior selection, until **April 27, 2020, at 11:59 p.m. EST.**
