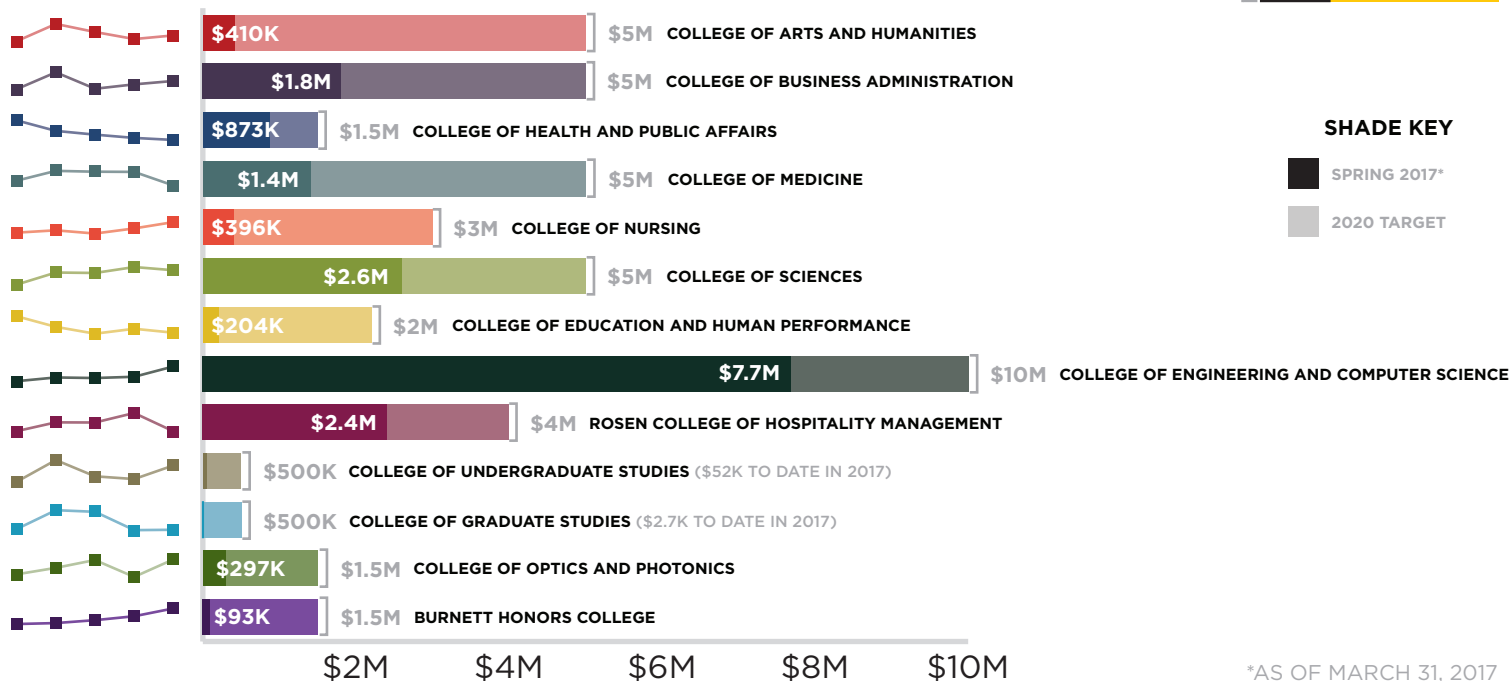

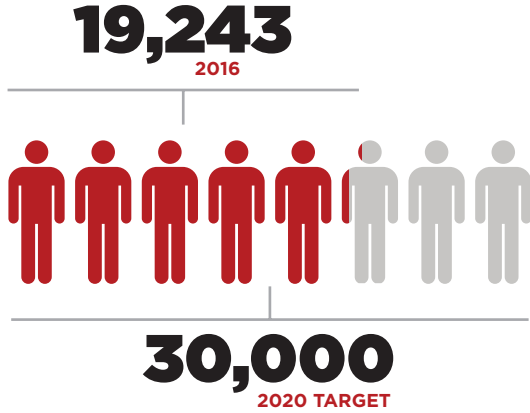

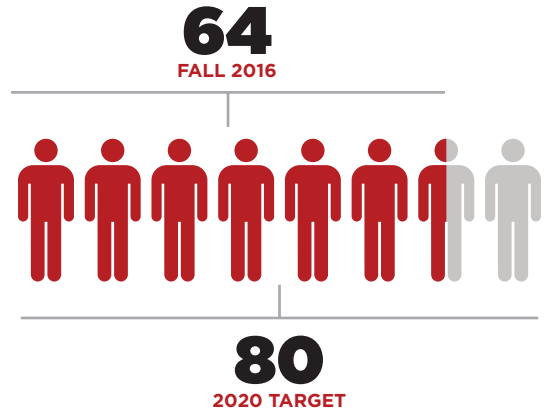
ALUMNI GIVING

ENDOWED PROFESSORSHIPS AND CHAIRS

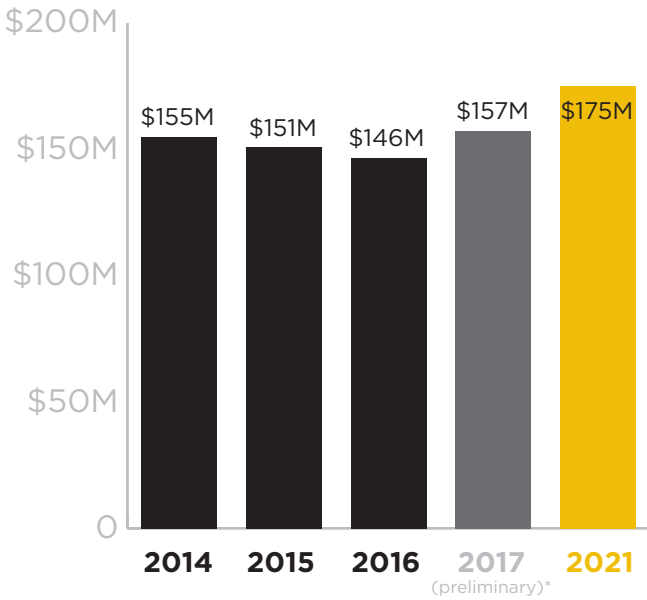
Increase endowed professorships and chairs to 80 by 2020.

FOUNDATION ENDOWMENT

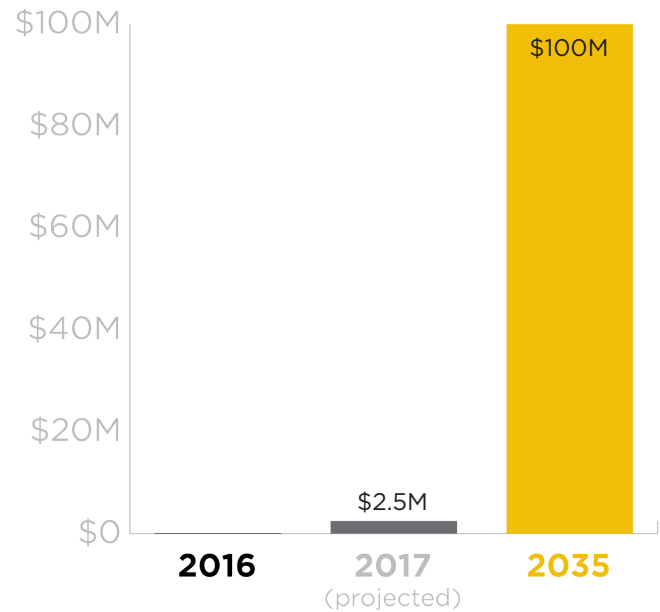
Increase UCF Foundation endowment to \$175 million by 2020.
