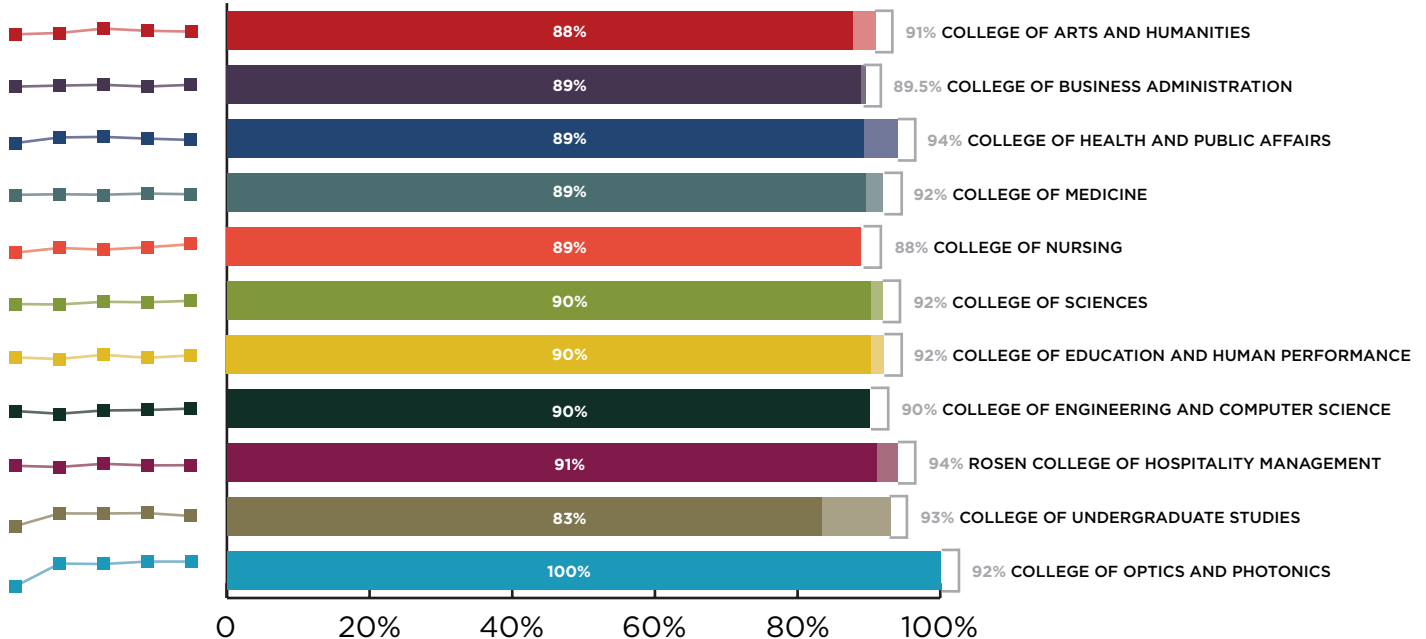

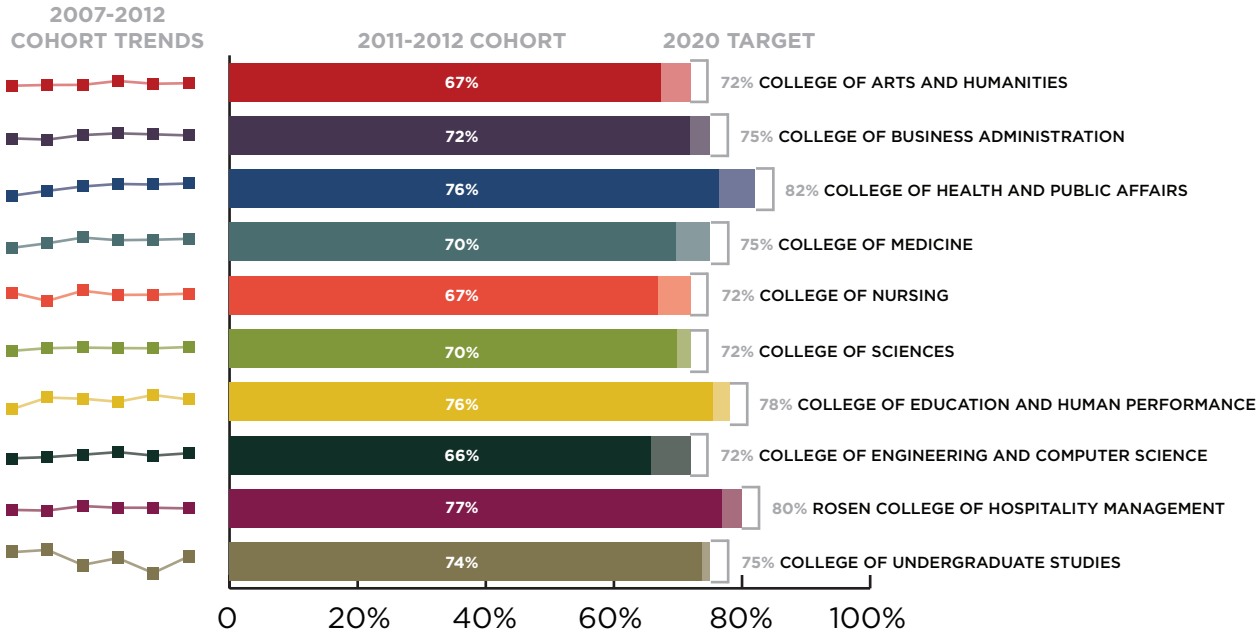
# 6-YEAR GRADUATION RATE

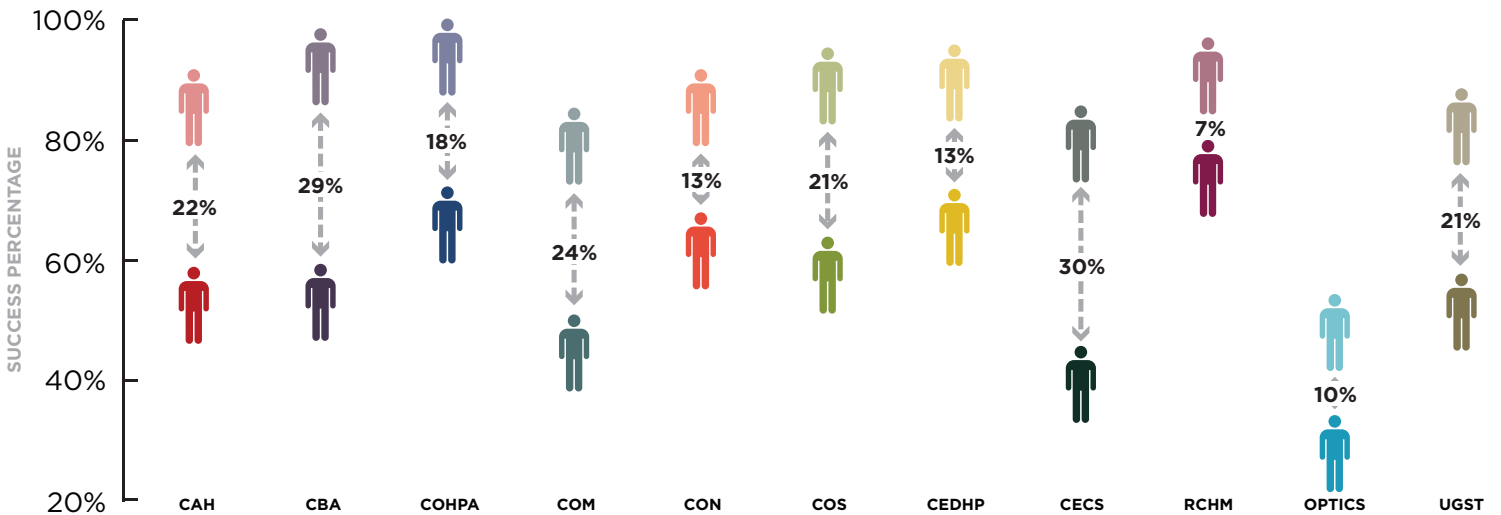
