ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the university's general admission requirements, you must provide:

- One official transcript in a sealed envelope from each college or university attended that shows a minimum 3.0 GPA
- A one or two-page essay indicating how the Executive Master of Health Administration program will enhance your career goals
- Resume (no longer than two pages)
- Evidence of a minimum of three years or more of relevant professional experience in healthcare and one year of leadership experience
- Three letters of recommendation that speak to your healthcare and/or management experience (one must be from your current supervisor)
