Differences in the Requirements for a BA or BS in Criminal Justice

• BA – Requires either two semesters of the same foreign language OR three semesters of American Sign Language, at the college level

• BS - Requires two years of foreign language at high school level

- CCJ 3024 Criminal Justice System (3 credit hours)
- CCJ 3014 Crime in America (3 credit hours)
- CCJ 4701 Research Methods in Criminal Justice (4 credit hours)
- CCJ 4746 Data Analysis for Criminal Justice (4 credit hours) (Required prerequisite is CCJ 4701.)
- CJE 4014 Police and Society (3 credit hours)
- CJE 3510 Prosecution and Adjudication (3 credit hours)
- CJC 3010 Corrections and Penology (3 credit hours)
- CCJ 4054 Capstone: Criminal Justice Ethics (3 credit hours) (Before taking the

Capstone course during the senior year, all core courses must be completed.)
