Today's rapidly changing world requires well-trained clinical social workers that will address the national, global and mental health challenges that impact individuals, families, groups and communities. With a career in social work, you'll gain a deeper understanding in how individuals are all interconnected and recognize that what affects one segment of our society or world may affect others.

Clinically focused and grounded in best practices for online learning, UCF's MSW is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE). Through course work and field experience you'll develop high-demand clinical social work skills and become competent, ethical practitioners prepared to impact the lives of individuals, families and communities experiencing health and mental health challenges.

WHO SHOULD CHOOSE THE PROGRAM?

UCF's fully online MSW program is specifically designed for those who are balancing school, work and life. Plus, with one class per term, it's flexible and convenient for your schedule — allowing you to learn when and where you want.

Two tracks available:

- **A three year, nine-semester track** designed specifically for those who have not earned a Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree. This track has classes offered in seven-week terms with one class per term.
- **A four-semester advanced standing track** for those who have earned a BSW from a CSWE-accredited program within the last six years. You must also have a 3.3 GPA in your last 60 credits and demonstrate academic potential and professional maturity to meet the demands of the program. This track consists of seven-week terms with one class per term.

Because these tracks can only be completed online, UCF charges an enhanced tuition rate. As such, online MSW students are unable to enroll in any other UCF certificate or graduate programs.
